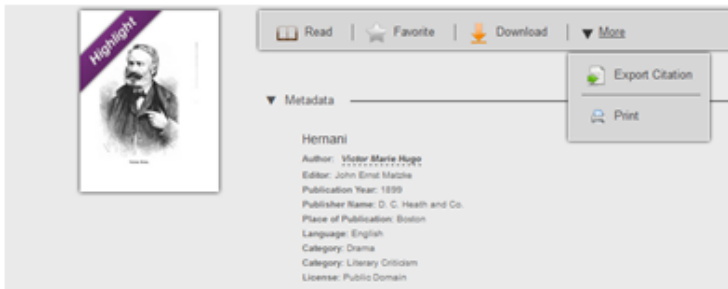




is a web-based multimedia authoring and presentation tool that allows libraries to upload locally owned content and view and curate collections of online public domain books, images, historical documents, and sounds and videos related to specific themes arranged in anthologies.

### **Biblioboard step by step directions for use:**

1. Connect to the Mass eBook Catalog through your library home page or <https://library.biblioboard.com/login>.
2. Choose **Sign Up Now** to set up your personal account, or **Login** if you're a return user.
3. Search for a topic or browse the listings for **Featured, Categories, or Modules**.
4. For example: Under *Categories*, select *Biography & Autobiography*; select *Abraham Lincoln: A Presidential Collection*; you will see icons for multiple formats, select *Books*; select any given title.
5. Clicking on a title will show more information.
